



The Fort Leonard Wood Blood Donor Center:

- Collects blood for the Armed Services Blood Program (the official blood collection and transfusion organization for the U.S. Military).
- Donors can donate whole blood every 57 days
- Donors can donate plasma every 28 days
- Accepts walk-in donors from 0800 to 1600 hours, Mon to Wed

Understanding Gifts & Donations

Why is understanding important?

- · The public has a desire to give
- · Supports Soldier, Family and Civilian Well-being
- Regulations/Statutes "Giving is confusing...its too hard"



Soliciting Gifts & Donations is Strictly Prohibited.

Government Employees (both Military and Civilian) cannot ask for donations from the public.

THERE IS **NO QUID PRO QUO** WITH DONATIONS (no strings attached)

Things Donor may want but we cannot deliver:

- Publicity/advertising
- Endorsement from the Army
- Special concessions/privileges
- Merchandising Opportunities

However... In response to an appropriate inquiry, you can inform potential donors of needs.

No Quid Pro Quo.

- AR 215-1, CH 13-14
- Joint Ethics Regulation
- OPORD U.S. Treasury Army Gift Fund Requirement
- Title 10, United States Code, Sec 2601
- DoD Financial Management Regulation 7000.14-R

STEP 1: Complete the HBB Application and any additional documentation (like licensing or certifications).

STEP 2: Complete the HBB Lease Addendum – if you need assistance or have questions reach out to your housing POC.

STEP 3: Turn in the Application: Once you've completed your paperwork, submit the application to your Family and MWR, 13486 Replacement Ave, Bldg... 470, Suite 1104. You may also mail your HBB application and supporting documents to megan.j.odonoghue.naf@mail.mil

Keep a copy of the completed application for your own records.

Family & MWR will route to the Garrison for approval and notify you once approved.
