

Welcome to FLW

- Access Control
 - Valid DoD ID
 - Visitor Pass obtained at the VCC
- Weapons Registration
 - Register weapons at the VCC within 24 hours of arrival (FLW Form 1835)
 - Declare weapons every time when entering the installation
- Weapons Safety
 - Firearms/weapons stored in FLW family housing will be kept:
 - Out of reach of children
 - Stored separately from ammunition
 - Under double lock when family housing unit is left unattended
