GLOBAL DATA TRANSFER (GDT) **ARE YOU PCSING?** DO YOU KNOW ABOUT GLOBAL DATA TRANSFER?

Global Data Transfer is designed to streamline the relocation process for military and civilian Families.

When you are preparing to move to a new duty station, Child and Youth Services (CYS) can upload basic Family information (such as names, birthdates, child health records, etc.) into a secure database through Global Data Transfer. This information will follow Families to their new duty stations and make the local CYS registration procedure shorter and simpler. All you need to do is provide the facility and/or Parent Central Services with an email address and recall it at your new Installation.

What is CEAT?

CEAT is a program that allows many current Army NAF employees to voluntarily request a non-competitive transfer to another Army installation where the same position may be available. Transfer requests are only authorized from one Army installation to another Army installation or a Joint Base if it is serviced by Army NAF Human Resources.

CEAT applies to NAF employees in the following categories:

•Child and Youth Program Assistants (CYPAs) •NF-03 and below •NAF FWS - NA, NL, and NS pay bands

Are you operating a Home-Based Business (HBB) on Fort Leonard Wood?

If the answer is YES, is your business REGISTERED?

HBBs include but are NOT limited to:

- · Hairdressing and hairstyling
- Home baking and meal preparation
- Pet grooming and pet sitting
- Massage therapy
- Multi-level sales activities
- Retail sales from home

<u>STEP 1</u>: Complete the HBB Application and any additional documentation (like licensing or certifications).

<u>STEP 2</u>: Complete the HBB Lease Addendum – if you need assistance or have questions reach out to your housing POC.

<u>STEP 3</u>: Turn in the Application: Once you've completed your paperwork, submit the application to your Family and MWR, 13486 Replacement Ave, Bldg. 470, Room 1104. You may also email your HBB application and supporting documents to megan.j.odonoghue.naf@army.mil

Keep a copy of the completed application for your own records.

Family & MWR will route to the Garrison for approval and notify you once a decision is made.
