



# MWR'S CARDS TO THE COMMUNITY COMPETITION

Visitors will enjoy the creativity presented in these holiday themed displays. Ribbons and bragging rights will be awarded to the top three designs and Best in Show!

## GENERAL RULES

- Open to all military and civilian; organizations, businesses, families, schools or individuals.
- Must use one 4'x8' piece of plywood to make card. The plywood must be cut in two pieces and hinged together. Each panel should be 4'x4'. To represent a greeting card.
- Participants are responsible for all materials needed.
- FMWR will not be responsible for materials damaged in transport or during display.
- Back of the card must be painted black and include your organization/business name on the back in the upper right hand corner with white exterior enamel paint.
- All cards must be able to stand up in the environment. They will be displayed for 4 weeks. We recommend using a primer to ensure quality paint coverage, and to help prevent the wood from warping.
- All cards must be anchored to the ground.
- Do not use lights or any other features that require electrical power. (electricity is not available)
- All entries will be displayed throughout the holiday season and will be spotlighted.

## **CARD SETUP**

All entries must coordinate their setup time with the Community Activities POC

All cards must be setup for display on the Joint Service Park 10:00 am and 2:00pm on Tuesday, December 03, 2019, in order to be judged. Community Activities staff will be on site to assist with placement during these hours. Entries unable to make this time is required to contact the Community Activities office at 596-6913 in advance to schedule a time for placement.

## **RECOVERY**

All participants are responsible for the recovery of their card. Cards are NOT to be removed prior to Thursday, January 2, 2020 and must be recovered no later than Friday, January 3, 2020 by 4 pm. Cards not recovered by 4 pm on Friday, January 3, 2020 will be discarded.

## **JUDGING**

Cards will be judged on Tuesday, December 03, 2019. We request that entries be present when the winners are announced on Tuesday, December 03, 2019, 5:30pm during the FMWR Tree Lighting at the Joint Services Park.

## **RIBBONS AND BRAGGING RIGHTS**

Best of Show

1st Place

2nd Place

3rd Place

Judging is based on a 5 point scale; 1: Good - 5: Outstanding. The card receiving the most points wins.

### **ONE**

Artistic Appeal: Use of color, decoration, etc. and how well they are incorporated into the design.

### **TWO**

Creativity of Theme: Not judged on content, but how well the creativity and the theme are executed .

### **THREE**

Design and Overall Workmanship: Overall appeal (aesthetics) of the design. Workmanship and finish.

## **BEST OF SHOW**

Judges select one overall card from the entire show (all levels) as the overall favorite.
