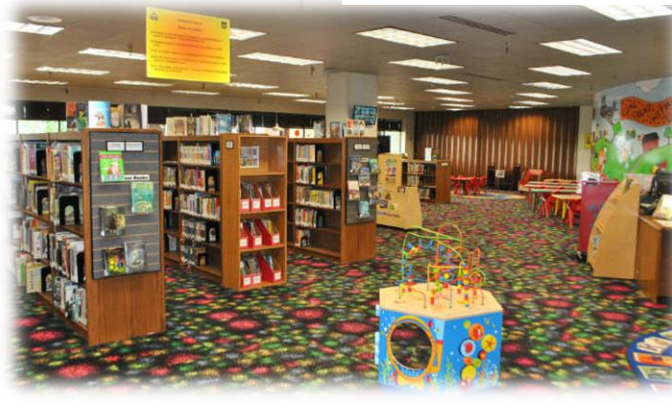

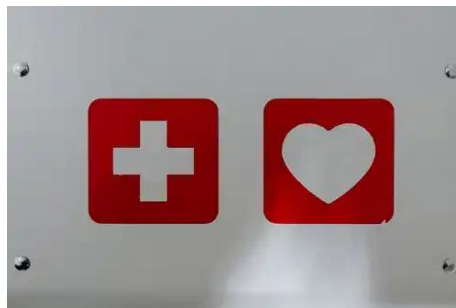

#### Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month

Each year, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration designates May as Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month. This observance coincides with the beginning of motorcycle riding season.

##### Motorcycle Driving Strategies

- 1) Gear Up!** Wear the proper PPE. T-shirt and sandals are not proper riding attire. Even jeans provide minimal protection against injury and road rash if you happen to slide. Choose to wear an approved helmet, and leather pants, jacket, boots and gloves.
- 2) Stay in the Comfort Zone!** Know your abilities. Your bike should fit you. If the bike feels too heavy, it probably is.
- 3) Inspect your Ride!** Give your bike a good once-over before hitting the road. Inspect tire pressure, mirror and lights before every ride.

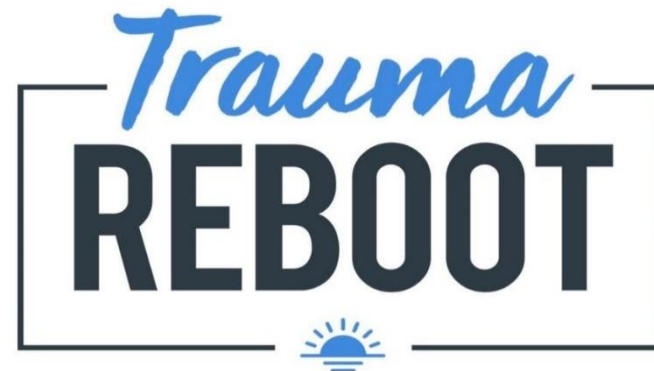
