ARMY EMERGENCY RELIEF (AER)



AER Annual Campaign March 1 through June 17

- Army goals Are: 100% awareness of AER Assistance
 25% donation rate from Soldiers (Army wide)
 \$5 per month from every Soldier
- AER Officer and staff to coordinate on-post campaign efforts
- AER Campaign staff to brief IET Soldiers and collect funds
- Cadre Soldiers will have AER rep in each Unit for campaign donations
- Goal is to be #1 AER Campaign in TRADOC for 4th year (70% rate)





ARMY EMERGENCY RELIEF CAMPAIGN



\$297,449 donations received from Soldiers in 2023

\$1,046,972 assistance provided to 628 soldiers

\$161,600 in scholarship grants to 45 spouses & children

AER has given \$1,208,572 in aid to Fort Leonard Wood community in 2023 \$4.06 in assistance for every \$1 donated to 2023 campaign at local level.

The 2023 Campaign reached 66.5% Soldier donation rate

The 2024 Campaign goal of **70%** donation rate is **ONLY 250 more** donations

TARGETED CARE

What is it?

- DHA wide effort to maximize efficiency of limited Behavioral Health Resources where they are needed most.
- Creates a screening process that better identifies needs of the service member and gets them to the appropriate resource.
- Increases group therapy which enables more service members to receive treatment than individual appointments.

DOES:

- Increases access to care for service members in need.
- Decreases wait time for Behavioral Health appointments.
- Ensures cooperation between several resources ensuring service members do not "fall through the cracks."

DOES NOT:

- Turn service members away.
- "Pass the buck" to an unqualified agency
- Eliminate individual therapy for service members in need.



HOME BASED BUSINESS



Are you operating a Home-Based Business (HBB) on Fort Leonard Wood?

If the answer is YES, is your business REGISTERED?

HBBs include but are NOT limited to:

- Hairdressing and hairstyling
- Home baking and meal preparation
- Pet grooming and pet sitting
- Massage therapy
- Multi-level sales activities
- Retail sales from home

STEP 1: Complete the HBB Application and any additional documentation (like licensing or certifications).

STEP 2: Complete the HBB Lease Addendum – if you need assistance or have questions reach out to your housing POC.

STEP 3: Turn in the Application: Once you've completed your paperwork, submit the application to your Family and MWR, 13486 Replacement Ave, Bldg. 470, Room 1104. You may also email your HBB application and supporting documents to

Keep a copy of the completed application for your own records.

Family & MWR will route to the Garrison for approval and notify you once a decision is made.


