COVID-19 VACCINES

Vaccines are voluntary, not mandatory

BENEFITS OF VACCINE:

- IT'S YOUR PERSONAL CHOICE: TO THE RESEARCH. GET THE FACTS. DO THE RESEARCH. · Vaccines are historically the most effective tool to
 - Creates antibodies (immune response) without having virus
 - Prevents serious illness if infected
 - · Protects you and those around you
 - Helps build community immunity and resilience

It's safe:

- Clinically tested
- Verified by the FDA
- Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) is a scientifically accepted process
- · Minimal side effects (e.g. soreness at injection site, fever, tiredness, aches)
- Allergic reactions low (11 reactions per million vaccines)

It's effective:

- · Works with immune system to fight virus if exposed
- Reduces likelihood of getting sick
- Will not make you sick
- Does not contain live virus
- 95% effective at preventing the disease

COVID-19 RISKS:

To you:

- Severe Illness or death
- Life-threatening complications
- · Long-term health effects like respiratory, cognitive and heart issues
- · Potential to be re-infected

To community:

- Continued protective posture (social distancing, masks, isolation, quarantine, etc.)
- · High risk of infecting others
- Effects of COVID-19 vary person-to person
- Sustained disruption to life activities

To healthcare system:

- Fewer resources for routine care
- Stress on hospitals
- Limits medical care treatment availability
- · Greater demand for mental health support

- Winter Weather
 - Change in road status

Green: No safety threat to the public due to weather conditions. Proceed with normal operations.

Amber: Difficult to hazardous road conditions. Drivers must slow to 10 mph below the posted speed limit to maintain traction and a safe stopping distance. Roads are icy or snow packed, but clearing operations are making roads passable.

Red: Most intersections present difficult or no stopping conditions. Weather forecast calls for continued precipitation with below freezing temperatures. Clearing operations have not kept priority number one roads easily passable. Black ice or ice sheeting has made passage hazardous. Safe speed limit is 10 to 15 mph regardless of posted limit, driving above 10 to 15 mph causes vehicles to lose traction and safe stopping distances are significantly increased.

Black: Restriction of all vehicular traffic on Fort Leonard Wood. Emergency vehicles are unrestricted (military police, ambulances, fire trucks, DPW, SNAIR support team mission essential vehicles). Non-emergency vehicles must obtain approval from their authorized delegated officer.



1) Home Based Business Process

- FY20 was a transioning year for the Home Based Business from the Housing Division to DFMWR with Garrison remaining the approving official.
- The Army has a new standardized HBB application that includes obtaining approval from installation agencies like Housing, Balfour Beatty, AAFES, JAG before the application goes for final approval.
- The development and the year were not without challenges however a policy has been written to streamline the process.
- The HBB owner is responsible for obtaining the necessary permissions, applicable licenses, and liability insurance. The HBB owner is also responsible for any damages to third parties arising from the conduct of the business.


