GLWACH

Community Interest:

- Current trends COVID-19 cases/PH concerns:
 - The highly contagious Delta Variant is driving an increase of COVID-19 cases on FLW and in the surrounding community
 - We have seen some breakthrough cases in those that are fully vaccinated, expect this as more people are vaccinated
 - Most persons fully vaccinated who have symptoms have mild to moderate symptoms
 - Most COVID-19 cases that are hospitalized are in those who have not been fully vaccinated
 - Vaccines are still very effective at preventing severe disease and is our best tool to end the pandemic
 - If you have symptoms, please get tested, even if fully vaccinated, and stay home until you know your results
 - If you are not fully vaccinated and are a close contact, stay home for 14 days and monitor for symptoms, if fully vaccinated, wear a mask if you are a close contact for 14 days and monitor for symptoms
 - If positive stay home 10 days and let anyone who you may have been in close contact with know



STEP 2: Complete the HBB Lease Addendum – if you need assistance or have questions reach out to your housing POC.

STEP 3: Turn in the Application: Once you've completed your paperwork, submit the application to your Family and MWR, 13486 Replacement Ave, Bldg. 470, Suite 1104. You may also mail your HBB application and supporting documents to megan.j.odonoghue.naf@mail.mil
Keep a copy of the completed application for your own records.

Family & MWR will route to the Garrison for approval and notify you once approved.



- ✓ Be sure to bring your military ID card or driver's license. You'll need them to check in.

Directions to our new facility:

- ✓ Follow Missouri Avenue to North Dakota and merge right at the electronic marquee.
- ✓ Follow North Dakota to Iowa and turn left.
- ✓ Follow Iowa to West 11th Street and turn right. This is directly across from Gammon Field
- √ Follow West 11th Street to Buckeye. The new donor center is right across the street.
